COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATE April 8, 2021

As of Monday, April 5, all residents age 16 and older are now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. The Pfizer vaccine is the only COVID-19 vaccine currently approved for individuals ages 16 and 17. The Central Racine County Health Department, the City of Racine Public Health Department, and the Community-Based COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic at Regency Mall all currently have the Pfizer vaccine available. All sites require an appointment. In most cases, a parent or guardian must be present for appointments for 16- and 17-year-olds.
