As of January 1, 2022, Central Racine County Health Department merged with Racine County as Racine County Public Health Division (RCPH).

The department moved to a new office space located at 9531 Rayne Rd. in Sturtevant.

CHIP/CHA

WORKFORCE UPDATES

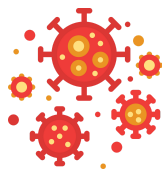
RCPH introduced a new role to the department - Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS). This role focuses on communicable disease and outbreak investigation.

RCPH passed new ordinances as part of Racine County government which became Chapter 21 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances

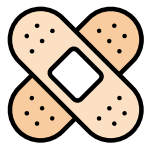


COMMUNITY HEALTH



COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

- 17,203 confirmed and probable communicable disease reports
- 96% of those reports were COVID-19



CLINIC SERVICES

- RCPH provided:
- 47 pediatric vaccinations
 - 20 TB Skin Tests
 - 11 adult vaccinations



FETAL, INFANT, & CHILD DEATH REVIEW

- Led 3 FICDR meetings
- 8 childhood deaths
- 10 infant deaths
- Stillbirth count is pending



SUICIDE PREVENTION

- Re-launched suicide prevention labels to transition to 988
- Developed new 988/Columbia Protocol card with NAMI Racine County



OVERDOSE FATALITY REVIEW

- Rates of overdose continue to rise in Racine County
- Led 5 OFR meetings
- Partnered with Racine County Behavioral Health Services to plan Overdose Awareness Day event



HOME VISITING

- Healthy Families America:
 - 863 home visits provided to 100 families
- Universal Home Visiting:
 - 142 families received a postpartum nurse home visit

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

FOOD SAFETY

- RCPH released an updated food safety training video and quiz for individuals and groups who serve food to the public.



BEACHES

- Monitored water for presence of E.coli
- Posted 5 caution and 3 closed signs throughout the 2022 beach season



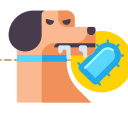
LICENSES

- 1067 total inspections completed in 2022
- 716 licenses issued



RABIES

- 134 rabies investigations completed
- 92% of investigations involved a dog



LEAD HAZARD INVESTIGATION

RCPH provided education to 9 children with an elevated blood lead level (BLL). 7 of those 9 accepted a home environmental assessment.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS



- Updated RCPH Public Health Emergency Plan (PHEP)
- Updated Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP)
- Participated in 3 tabletop exercises

WELL WATER
