What is Home Visiting?

Family Support Workers deliver learning and support to the comfort of your home. Our home visiting program will give your child an advantage, a head start to learning. It will help build the foundations for success and prepare your child for school. Being part of our program will help maximize your child's learning potential!

Who Can Join?

Any expectant or new parent who lives in Racine County may be eligible to join the home visiting program.

What Does It Cost?

The home visiting program is free!
There are also no income requirements.

How Often Do We Meet?

Our program usually starts before birth and continues until your child reaches preschool age. Long term service allows us to help you as your child develops and family needs change.

What Do We Do At Each Visit?

Each home visit is tailored to fit you and your family's needs! At each visit, we will focus on:

Screenings

We do developmental screenings of your baby to help make sure your baby is developing on schedule. We also measure your baby so you can see how he/she grows.

Education

We will bring along any information that you are interested in or want to learn more about.

Activities

We do activities to encourage bonding. Activities are focused on stimulating and improving your baby's five senses: touch, taste, sight, smell, and hear.

Support

There are times when even the best parents feel overwhelmed and stressed. We can help provide additional support to help you manage your daily stress.

Goal Setting

We will develop a Family Goal Plan together that is centered on your needs and interests. The program will be based on this plan.

Referral

We will help connect you to community resources that may benefit you!
